Compliance is defined when the organization demonstrates that there is no noncompliance to any applicable criteria. Non-compliance to the Sabah Legality Standard occurs when the organization does not comply with 1 or more criteria. Non-compliance must be formally addressed prior to certification or within 2 months following a surveillance assessment.

The information presented in this report is based on documentation and other information presented by the client and observations made during the field verification under the assessment. **Gap 005/2019 (Raised to Minor) – Checklist 5.3.3 and 5.3.6:** The licensee shall rectify the issues raised by DOSH as required.
