Terms of Assessment

The scope of the evaluation is to verify compliance of the **Fook Ngiap Sawmill Sdn. Bhd.** (Sukses Jadi **Sdn. Bhd.**) to the criteria within the Sabah Timber Legality Assurance System (TLAS) Principle 5 - Mill Operations and Principle 6 -Trade and Customs standards. Compliance is defined when the organization demonstrates that there is no non-compliance to any applicable criteria. Non-compliance to the Sabah Legality Standard occurs when the organization does not comply with 1 or more criteria. Non-compliance must be formally addressed prior to certification or within 2 months following a surveillance assessment.

Limitations of Assessment

The information presented in this report is based on documentation and other information presented by the client and observations made during the field verification under the assessment. Reporting of information presented by the client is taken as accurate, unless evaluated differently through the observations made during the assessment. All information presented in the report is accurate and complete to the best of knowledge of GFS.

Background Information:

Fook Ngiap Sawmill Sdn. Bhd. (Fook Ngiap Sawmill) mill license is leased to Sukses Jadi Sdn. Bhd. (Sukses Jadi) to produce veneer and sawn timber. The company produces and trades rotary veneer for export to South Korea, India, Taiwan, Japan and also for local market. Fook Ngiap Sawmill also rents to Majestic Goldtree Sdn. Bhd. (1181263-K). Majestic Goldtree Sdn. Bhd. (Majestic Goldtree) is applying for mill contractor license under FDS. Sukses Jadi provides sawmilling service to Majestic Goldtree.

The previous assessment was conducted in July 2018 that resulted in 2 gap(s) and 1 observation(s) (report #: G162-442).

Sukses Jadi does not engage other companies as their subcontractors to provide or manufacture products.

008/2019	Minor	5.2.5	New	July 2019: Inconsistency of labeling batch number on WIP materials and finished products. No identification of Sabah TLAS on WIP sampled at the sawmill. Issuance of batch number not consistent with the company CoC manual.

Fook Ngiap Sawmill Sdn. Bhd. (Sukses Jadi Sdn. Bhd.) has demonstrated compliance with the Sabah Standard Principles 5-6 for Chain of Custody and is recommended to receive a GFS Audit Statement and STCC from FDS.

Minor Gap(s)/Observation(s) identified in this assessment should be addressed before the next surveillance visit. Action required to close the gap(s)/observation(s) include:

Gap 006/2018 (Minor) Outstanding – Checklist 5.2.2: Forestry Department of Sabah shall ensure removal passes from Sabah TLAS verified suppliers are stamped with Sabah TLAS Compliant.

Gap 007/2019 (Minor) – Checklist 5.2.4: The company shall update the CoC manual to identify batch production unit for Sabah TLAS production along with reference for allocation of Sabah TLAS logs into a batch production unit or identification of work in progress (WIP) through finished products.

Gap 008/2019 (Minor) – Checklist 5.2.5: Ensure all WIPs and finished products were labeled with batch number for tracebility. Identification of Sabah TLAS material shall be included in each production batch and issuance batch number shall consistent with the company CoC manual.

Gap 009/2019 (Minor) – Checklist 5.3.1: The company shall provide all foreign workers with Foreign Worker Compensation scheme or covered under SOCSO starting 2019.

Gap 010/2019 (Minor) – Checklist 5.3.2: The company shall provide sufficient PPE based on the job scope. Records of PPE distribution shall be maintained by the company.

Gap 011/2019 (Minor) - Checklist 5.3.3: The DOSH inspection book shall be maintained at the mill.

The next surveillance visit is scheduled in May 2020.
