Terms of Assessment

The scope of the evaluation is to verify compliance of the Sabah, Malaysia. Borneo Build & Supply Sdn. Bhd. to the criteria within the Sabah Timber Legality Assurance System (TLAS) Principle 5 - Mill Operations and Principle 6 -Trade and Customs standards. Compliance is defined when the organization demonstrates that there is no non-compliance to any applicable criteria. Non-compliance to the Sabah Legality Standard occurs when the organization does not comply with 1 or more criteria. Non-compliance must be formally addressed prior to certification or within 2 months following a surveillance assessment.

Limitations of Assessment

The information presented in this report is based on documentation and other information presented by the client and observations made during the field verification under the assessment. Auditor's reporting of information presented by the client are taken as accurate, unless evaluated differently through the observations made during the assessment. All information presented in the report is accurate and complete to the best of knowledge of.

Background Information:

Makeson Sdn. Bhd. (Makeson) mill license and mill contractor license are leased to Borneo Build & Supply Sdn. Bhd. (715981-W) (Borneo Build & Supply) and WVT Timber Industries Sdn. Bhd.(1225533-T) (WVT) to produce moulding products and sawn timber respectively.

Borneo Build & Supply produced moulding and sold to Borneo Benar. The company had formally registered with the Company Commission of Malaysia in Sabah dated 25/11/2005 with a registration number 715981-W.

The previous assessment was conducted in March 2018 that resulted in 3 gap(s) and 0 observation(s) (report #: G162-406)

Associated Organizations & Subcontractors:

Borneo Build & Supply is associated to the company Mostim Sdn. Bhd. and Borneo Benar Sdn. Bhd. that involved in the company's management. The company engaged Terus Maju Enterprise 2 as a subcontractor to provide and manufacturing products.

Presently, Borneo Build & Supply only purchases logs from FSC certified forest (Deramakot Forest Reserve) and subsequently engaged Kilang Kayu Lohan Sdn. Bhd. for logs processing before transporting the purchased logs to their mill.

Description of the Supply Chain:
